Title of your proposal;  
Complete names and contacts of all presenters: name, address, email, professional role;  
Abstract not to exceed fifty (50) words;  
Relevance and contribution to the field of special education;  
Proposed format: lecture, workshop, panel, poster, and or round table;  
Time needed: 30, 45, 60 minutes or longer

- Proposals will be reviewed by the program committee for content, degree of audience appeal, quality and organization. The committee reserves the right to change titles and descriptions for brevity, clarity and consistency.
- ALL accepted PRESENTERS are required to register for the conference by the established deadlines or their names will not appear in the conference program.** IASE does not pay travel or hotel expenses for presenters. If multiple presenters are included, the first author is responsible for making certain that all session **accepted** presenters are registered for the conference in a timely manner. Note: Presenters are limited to one major presentation. English is the conference language.
- Accepted and registered presenters will have the option to publish in the Conference Proceedings. Additionally selected papers may be invited for publication in The Journal of the International Association of Special Education.
- Proposals that promote commercially available products, services, or programs will not be accepted. The venue for commercially available products will take place at our Exhibition Showcase Session.
